COLLEGE COUNSELING BY GRADE

Grade 9: Thinking Ahead Transcripts, GPA calculation, advice from seniors, college campus visit

Grade 10: Early Start SAT/ACT prep, summer programs, résumé building, personality and career assessment

Grade 11: College 101 College 101 class that includes self-advocacy and college research, college fair, test prep, campus visits, application anatomy, and building a balanced list; begin individual work with college counselor

Grade 12: Final Stretch Refining of college list with a focus on fit, crafting effective essays, completing applications and putting all the pieces together, making decisions
